

PREDICTIONS AND PLANS FOR COMET P/SHOEMAKER-LEVY 9

The planetary science community is gearing up for an all-out effort to observe the collision of Comet P/Shoemaker-Levy 9 with Jupiter. Special telescope time allocations for the events have been made at major observatories around the world and in orbit above it. The Galileo spacecraft will be observing the collisions.
